

What the Cowlitz Tribe is proposing

The Cowlitz Tribe applied to take nearly 152 acres of rural Clark County land into trust for developing a large-scale casino-resort. The Record of Decision outlines a casino-hotel complex comprising:

- a 134,150-square-foot gaming floor with 3,000 video lottery terminals (slots), 135 gaming tables and 20 poker tables
- a 250-room hotel—150,480 square feet
- 355,225 square feet for retail, restaurants and public space
- 147,500 square feet of convention and multipurpose space with seating up to 5,000

Additionally, it would include:

- two parking garages totaling 5,500 stalls
- valet parking for 1,750 vehicles
- an RV park with 200 spaces
- 20,000 square feet of tribal office space
- a 12,000-square-foot cultural center including museum and offices
- 16 housing units for tribal elders
- an on-site wastewater treatment plant
